

Hydroxychloroquine, Rheumatic Diseases amidst the Covid-19 Pandemic: *Overcoming checkpoints & roadblocks*

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Introduction: Covid pandemic has led to an acute shortage of hydroxychloroquine (HCQ) for our patients. Here and around the world, concerns of HCQ supply shortages for patients with rheumatic disease are increasing due in part to the interest of the scientific community for HCQ as potential therapy for Covid-19.

Clinical trials testing HCQ to treat Covid-19 have started as early as March paving the way for further researches. In our country, chloroquine (CQ) and HCQ are being used as compassionate care for Covid-19 in hospitals like the Lung Center of the Philippines. Meanwhile, its use in lupus include prevention of flare-ups while also improving cholesterol levels, the skin, joints and even prevention of blood clots. Hence, its impact on the over-all survival of these group of patients is significant. Similarly, its use in other rheumatic diseases like Rheumatoid arthritis (RA) as a disease modifying anti-rheumatic drug (DMARD) had long been recognized thereby preventing joint damage and reducing the risk of long-term disability.

Filipino rheumatologists recognized and anticipated the dire consequences of this shortage in supply of HCQ, and kept in close touch with their patients and pharmacies to be continually updated on availability of stocks.

The enduring capacity of the Bayanihan Act and the people behind its implementation to be translated into real-time action had moved every sector of the government to respond to the call of these challenging times. In so manner, Lupus Inspired Advocacy (LUISA) of the Rheumatology

Educational Trust Foundation Inc. (RETFI) under its Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Dr. Sandra V. Navarra and patient liaison Ms. Robelle Tananganan, partnered with Cancer Warriors Foundation headed by Ms Carmen Auste, and Psoriasis Philippines (PsorPhil) headed by Sir Josef de Guzman, in a feverish rush to deliver donated HCQ from the Department of Health for lupus and RA patients all throughout the country, undeterred by checkpoints and roadblocks. It was truly heartwarming and gratifying to have a surge of volunteers working round-the-clock to ensure that lupus and RA patients receive the donated HCQ tablets. As of May 31, 2020, a total of 985 patients all over the Philippines received free HCQ amidst the COVID19 pandemic (see figure)!



Postscript 15 June 2020:

”HCQ No Longer Approved Even a Little for COVID-19”

— Study after study showed no benefit, and now the FDA has had enough

Finally on June 15, FDA rescinded its emergency use authorization (EUA) of HCQ to treat COVID-19 patients, citing HCQ as “**unlikely to be effective** at treating COVID-19”.

Nonetheless, the HCQ ‘direct delivery’ experience to rheumatic disease patients in the last 3 months has been an eye-opener to the plight of our patients at a time of pandemic and a uniquely gratifying learning experience for patients, physicians and drug delivery services alike!



Ang Lupus Support Group of Panay (LSPGP) ay isang organisasyon ng mga taong na diagnose ng lupus. Layunin ang organisasyon na tumulong at magbigay impormasyon sa mga pasyenteng may lupus upang mas mapagtakumpayan nila ang kanilang laban kontra sa kanilang sakit. Mahirap para sa karamihan ng myembroong may lupus ang araw araw na pagsusentento sa kanilang mga gamot, at mas lalong naging mahirap ng dumating ang pandemyang covid19. Ang lahat ng myembroong may lupus at umiinom ng hydroxychloroquine o mas kilala sa brand names na plaquenil, hcqs at hyquin, ay nanawagan upang sila'y dinggin at huwag ipagdamot sa kanila ang kanilang gamot. Dahil ginagamit ang hcqs sa paggamot ng mga taong nagkakasakit ng covid19, naubusan ng gamot na hcqs sa mga botika. Ang gamot na hcqs, kasama ng iba pang gamot, ay tumutulong upang maiwasan ang pag active ng sakit ng isang taong may lupus. Noong nag-announce ng ECQ, I was able to buy supply pa ng HCQS. Kampante pa ako that time kase sabi nung pharmacist hindi naman daw sila nawawalan ng stock. Hindi ko inexpect na mag eextend pa yung quarantine period tapos yun nga nagkakaibusan ng supply ng HCQS sa mga drugstores at napabalita nga na ginagamit ito pang-gamot sa mga covid-19 patients. Allegedly, may mga reports din na may mga bumibili din daw nito to use it as prophylaxis drug against covid-19. Before maubos yung HCQS ko, palagi na akong tumatawag sa mga Mercury branches na malapit sa area namin pero palaging walang stocks. I started na mag-worry kung anong magiging effect kung hindi ako makainom ng gamot. November pa yung last visit ko sa Rheuma ko at laboratory tests so wala akong idea kung kumusta ngayon ang overall health condition ko. Andun yung mga negative thoughts na pwedeng mangyari saken sa hindi pag-inom ng HCQS. Pero eventually naisip ko na hindi yun makakatulong sa health ko. I lean on this verse instead:

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." Philippians 4:6 NIV

Then, nalaman ko yung about sa binibigay na free HCQS ng LUISA. Nag sign up agad ako, hoping na makakatanggap ako. Hindi ako nakareceived ng call galing sa kanila hindi tulad ng mga kasamahan ko sa Lupus Society of Batangas. But then, I put my trust na lang na si Lord ang bahala saken. He will provide for me. At yun nga, May 20 nakatanggap ako ng call from J&T informing me na nasa labas siya ng gate ng subdivision namin. When I opened the package, 6 boxes of HCQS ang laman. Natuwa ako kase talagang gumagawa ng way si Lord. Thankful ako sa mga taong behind ng project na ito ng free HCQS para sa mga lupus patients na katulad ko na hirap makakuha ng supply. 

Plaquenil/HCQS/Hydroxychloroquine has always been one of my maintenance since I was diagnosed with SLE. Kaya noong nagsimula ang pandemic na covid at naisama nila ito as one of the effective treatments daw ng virus, nahirapan akong maghanap sa mga pharmacy. At sa mercury drug ko lng ito nabibili dahil wala ito sa ibang pharmacy.

May time na nag every other day ako as per prescribed by my doctor para lang po ma extend yung remaining stock ko ng gamot. Pero kapag hindi ako nakaka inom,

iba talaga ang pakiramdam ko compared sa nakaka inom ako. Minsan pagod and katawan, or naglalabasan ang rashes ko, o kaya naman ay nanakit ang joints ko. Kaya ang saya ko noong sinabi sa akin ng doctor ko na meron daw ipapamigay ang LUISA na libreng hcqs.

Financially, malaki ng tulong yan dahil sobrang mahal ng gamot na yan at syempre, ilang araw din na meron akong sure na maiinom habang naghahanap ako ng mabilhan ko para sa future days. Sa totoo lang, hindi ako nag expect na may dadating sa akin bilang nasa mindanao area pa ako. Pero on May 30, na surprised ako dahil may delivery na dumating. Akala ko nung una online na order. Yun pala ang gamot ko.
